CONCORD, NH — The Community Development Finance Authority (CDFA), in Concord, NH, recently added a member to its Board of Directors.

Mr. Dick Ingram, Executive Director of The Housing Partnership in Portsmouth, NH and resident of North Hampton, NH, was appointed by the Governor and will serve a five year term on the CDFA Board of Directors. Prior to The Housing Partnership, Mr. Ingram was the President of the Greater Portsmouth Chamber of Commerce. He has extensive financial management and nonprofit experience. He also serves on the Board of Directors of the Northern New England Housing Investment Fund, as well as the Seacoast Repertory Theatre, SeaCare Health Services, and the Episcopal Diocese of New Hampshire. Mr. Ingram earned a Masters in Business Administration from the University of Pittsburgh.

CDFA, created by legislation in 1983, is a nonprofit public instrumentality of the State of New Hampshire. CDFA administers \$14 million in annual funding resources, which includes a combination of state tax credits and federal Community Development Block Grant funding.
